Information is fundamental. Just like when a house is built, what makes it livable is its connection to the rest of the community, so it is the **circulation of information** that enables every member of the Humanist Movement in any part of the planet, to **know** where and how many we are, and what we are doing. Information makes **interchange** possible and strengthens the **activities**; it enables us to **diffuse our ideas** and to make other **people join in**. For this reason we collect the **files** of the members, periodically we draw up brief **notes** on our activities all around the world, we print **books** with our fundamental ideas, the **essence** of the Humanist Movement.

Where?

The **weekly meeting** is the central moment in which the administrative sector makes this information available to the structure in order that anyone can use it. Information can circulate in any way and with any instrument created on purpose: posters, photocopies, bulletins, e-mail, internet, videos, CDs, tapes, books and - why not - orally.



How does he work?

In practice :

1 - he **quarterly** receives a material from the admi sector of the higher level and gives it to the members of the council he belongs to. He counts and records the number of persons who received that material.

2 - he helps the oriator in **collecting quarterly data** (forms of structure members, adherents, humanist centers, newspapers, materials) and in sending them quarterly to the admi sector of the higher council.

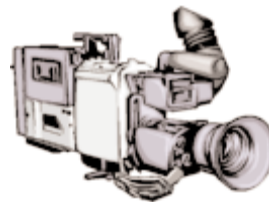

Which are the materials he gives to the structure?



The materials we provide the structure with are:

- **Explanations about the organization of the movement** (*Theory of organization, information about the group, the meeting, the adherents, self-financing, Assembly organization, Organisms and action fronts*)
- List of **web sites** of the Humanist Movement
- Brochures on our **books**

Is there any other material?

The oriator can suggest to give some additional material to the structure:

- **Activities bulletin** (which is released twice a year by the Council 35)
- **Quarterly data** (which are gathered, processed and spread again to the structure)
- **Organization charts**, describing graphically how people and councils are organized.
