Through formation we foster the widening of the participants' point of view on our world

By formation we mean the reading of topics taken from the official documents of the Humanist Movement. These topics are related to the present social administrative situation, and offer new points of view on economy, values, human action.



How does he / she work?

The weekly meeting is the moment when formation takes place: the support sector reads topics decided together with the orientor. After the reading, comments based on personal experience can be shared. This phase won't take more than 20 - 30 minutes, so that time is left for other topics. If participants want to talk more in depth, they can do it after the meeting or in the following days.



The support sector attends to the meetings of the support sectors, where the formation

topics are read and discussed. These topics can be eventually used in the weekly meetings.
